

Application Delete Utility

Run this utility to delete the data records added to the PDSA tables by the Application Builder or other PDSA utilities. This utility will delete all application data and selected users.

Application Delete Utility

Run the PDSA Framework Utilities to access the Application Delete utility.

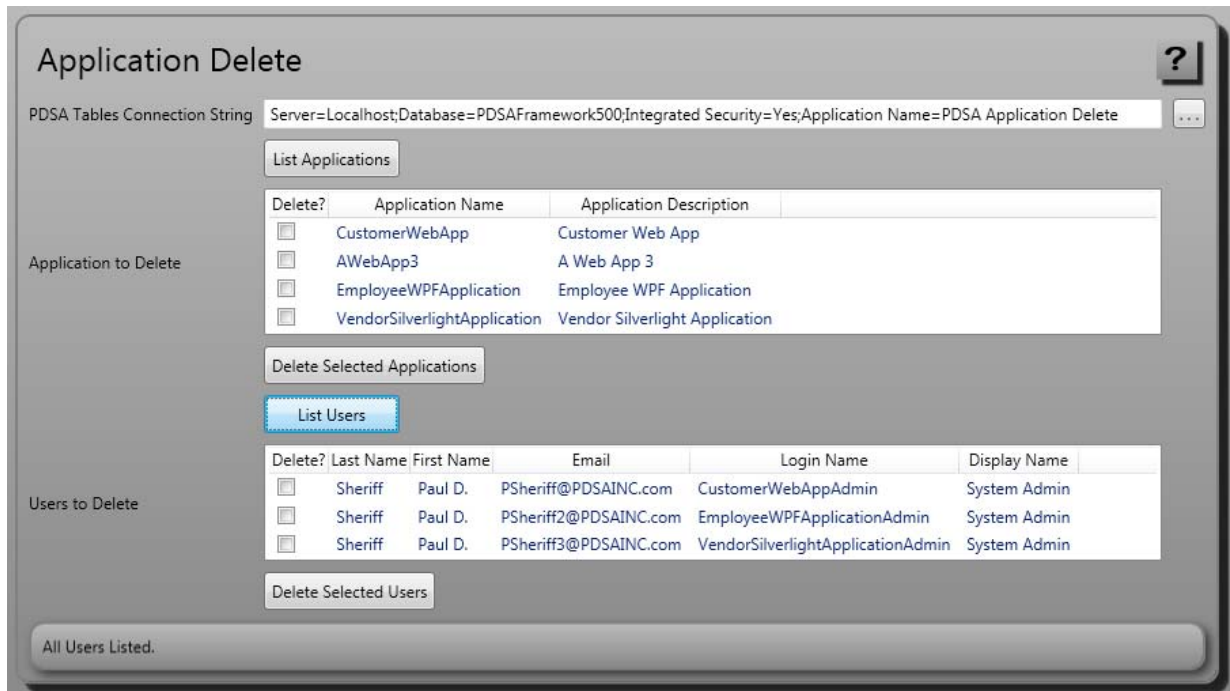


Figure 1: You can delete application data and users from your PDSA database using this utility.

When you click on the icon for the Application Delete utility you will see a screen that looks like Figure 1.

Delete Applications

Enter (or build) a connection string where the “PDSA” tables are located.

Click on the **List Applications** button.

If you successfully connect to the database where the PDSA tables are located, and there are applications in those PDSA Tables, then a list of applications will be displayed in the list.

Select the application(s) you wish to delete and click the **Delete Selected Applications** button.

Delete Users

After successfully getting a list of applications the List Users button will be enabled.

You can click on this **List Users** button to get a list of all users in the pdsaUser table.

Select the user(s) you wish to delete and click the **Delete Selected Users** button.

Summary

In this chapter you learned how to use the PDSA .NET Productivity Framework Application Builder utility to delete all the application data created by the Application Builder. This is useful if you accidentally created an application with the wrong name, or maybe you were doing a demo for someone and just want to remove an application.
